

WAYS OF GIVING: The mission of the Piarist Fathers is to follow Christ and to serve the church in the modern world by promoting our unique way of life and by ministering effectively to the educational needs of children and youth, especially the poor. To see the mission to fruition the Piarist USA Province seeks assistance to provide financial assistance for the formation and education of seminarians, for the health and well being of senior members and for the on going work of the active members.

I. ANNUAL GIVING: Gifts to the annual fund are an important part of the USA Province's development program. Annual Giving helps to educate our seminarians and to care for our senior members. The cost of care for a retiree per year is approximately \$22,000. On the average, they receive \$10,000 per year from social security and pensions.
